Monday, 13 September	open	OLW Kick-off	The opening session explaining and showing LOFT. Last chance to register for the coming events.	<p>Once upon a time... <i>Andreia Henriques and Peter Dral</i></p> <p>During the Open LOFT Week visitors on LOFT will have to chance to co-create a short and open-ended story. The story will be accompanied by illustrations developing throughout the week.</p> <p>An example and few suggestions will be provided for inspiration. Concept note on the use of pictures and story-telling as well as technical instructions will be developed and provided to story-tellers by the team.</p>
Tuesday, 14 September	18.00 – 19.30 GMT	Free Style Facilitation	Live connection with the 24 participants of the TALE practice training course “Free Style Facilitation” taking place in Ukraine in that week. On Sep 14 at the training there will be a session dedicated to the introduction of facilitation of learning, so the participants will work out their own understanding. In the evening in Hot Topic Café participants of the training and LOFT visitors will meet and discuss the issue.	
Wednesday, 15 September	3 hours	Piazza of inspiration	In the Piazza of inspiration participants-trainers will get a chance to exchange different kinds of tools that they developed, edited, discovered. It will be organised as a game in which participants give tools that they have and search for the tools they need.	
Thursday, 16 September	90 minutes	ChancE – NFE methods for all	This session allows participants to discuss and share experiences on how to use and promote the NFE approach for disadvantage youngsters and youth organizations having this target. In brief this is a strong tool to remove most of the barriers such as language, lack of expression, formality, etc, in education.	
Friday, 17 September	3 hours	Value based education	Live connection with the 30 participants of the TALE practice training course “Vale based education” taking place in Estonia during that week. The team of this training course will offer an online platform for people that wants to interact about value based education and spirituality. An online questionnaire for the participants will be created prior to the training. This tool can be involved in the OLW-session so others will also get the chance of reflecting on values in their personal and professional life.
